Control Cards (picture + label) - Cut along dotted lines

[Bird illustration]

Bird

The whole bird

[Beak illustration]

Beak

Used for eating, preening, and nest-building

[Wing illustration]

Wing

Feathered limb for flight and balance

[Tail Feathers illustration]

Tail Feathers

Act as a rudder and brake during flight

[Feet illustration]

Feet

Adapted for perching, swimming, or catching prey

[Breast illustration]

Breast

Houses powerful flight muscles

[Eye illustration]

Eye

Excellent vision; many birds see ultraviolet light

[Crown illustration]

Crown

Top of the head, often brightly colored

[Leg illustration]

Leg

Supports the bird when standing or walking
